Dear Mr. LaPorta:

This letter is in reply to your cc'd correspondence to the Department of Justice, dated July 25, 2010, which was referred to this Office for consideration and response. Your letter concerns your loan with Bank of America (BOA). You allege that Countrywide/BOA made you "fraudulent mortgage loans" and continues to "collect unauthorized mortgage payments." You now request a release of your mortgage debt and a refund for all interest and principal money you have paid to BOA. I note you have also cc'd this correspondence to BOA, the Federal Trade Commission, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Nevada Attorney General, as well as other individuals and agencies.

The Department of Justice is not authorized to provide private legal advice nor to represent individuals in their efforts to recover monetary losses in situations such as the one you describe.

Since your inquiry relates to a matter involving questions that do not come within the immediate jurisdiction of this Department, I am forwarding your letter to the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC). The OCC charters, regulates, and supervises all national banks. As Bank of America is a national bank, the OCC is the most appropriate agency to consider your complaint.
